

SALE OF THE VLCC ARDENNE VENTURE

ANTWERP, Belgium, 14 November 2013 – Euronav NV (NYSE Euronext Brussels: EURN) today announced that the company sold the double-hulled VLCC *Ardenne Venture* (2004 – 318,658 dwt), for USD 41.7 million. The vessel is owned by a 50/50 joint venture company with Wah Kwong Maritime Transport Holdings Ltd.

The capital gain on this sale of about USD 2.2 million (Euronav's part) will be recorded at delivery. The net cash proceeds available to Euronav after the mandatory repayment of its debt obligation will be USD 10.2 million. The vessel is foreseen to be delivered to its new owner between mid December 2013 and the beginning of February 2014.

VERKOOP VAN DE VLCC ARDENNE VENTURE

ANTWERPEN, België, 14 november 2013 – Euronav NV (NYSE Euronext Brussels: EURN) kondigde vandaag de verkoop aan van de *Ardenne Venture*, één van de dubbelwandige VLCC's (2004 – 318.658 dwt), voor een prijs van 41,7 miljoen USD. Het schip is eigendom van een 50/50 joint venture vennootschap met Wah Kwong Maritime Transport Holdings Ltd.

De meerwaarde op deze verkoop bedraagt ongeveer 2,2 miljoen USD (het deel van Euronav) en zal geboekt worden op het ogenblik van de levering. De vrij beschikbare cash gegenereerd door deze verkoop na de verplichte terugbetaling van de lening bedraagt 10,2 miljoen USD. De levering van het schip aan haar nieuwe eigenaar zal plaats vinden tussen midden december 2013 en begin februari 2014.
